Due to budget considerations we are asking that all participants pay for room and meals for the Regional Festival and the State Festival if we qualify. (In past years, the Administration has paid for travel fees and meals for State, but due to budget considerations, may not be able to pay for these things this year.) We also ask that each participant purchase a show T-shirt for all festivals. This total cost will be about \$100.00 for 1 - 2 nights in hotel, 1 t-shirt, 6 meals. More info and exact \$\$ and when it is due will follow.

Students must have an excuse to miss a rehearsal. All cast are needed at almost every rehearsal and all crew members must begin attending on Jan 23 if not before. Please call

We all have some work to do over the holiday break:

Cast: Clear your schedules. Read the original story which our 1-Act play is based upon, "A Rose for Emily" by William Faulkner. Begin Memorizing lines.

Crew: Clear your schedules and check the schedule for meeting dates and deadlines and work on costumes, makeup, props and lobby display items. Read the original story which our 1-Act play is based upon, "A Rose for Emily" by William Faulkner. All crew are welcome to attend any rehearsals prior to Jan 16 to become familiar with the show.

Cast will be allowed scripts for blocking rehearsals, but then I'd like you off book. The scripts are yours to keep and mark up.

Districts: If we get a I or II ranking we will advance on to the Regional Competition.

Regionals: We will not know until after Districts where our Regional will be. We often have to travel across the State to a location. We must take first or second place in order to qualify for State - very tough competition. These Saturday competitions are what this play is all about—meeting other students from around the state, watching theatre and participating in fun days! Be prepared for long days and lots of traveling. More details will follow as I get information on locations and times.

Snow Day Alert: If there is no school due to a snow day, there will be no rehearsal, unless we call you directly to say that we are rehearsing. *(It could happen!)* If you don't get a call, there will be NO REHEARSAL.

The trip slip is for all the Festivals we may be participating in this year. Parents need to sign them and get them turned in by Tuesday, December 16.

It is a tradition at these festivals that each school wear their show T-shirts when not performing. It kind of acts as an ice breaker when meeting and socializing with students from other schools. \$15.00 from each student is due by Tuesday, January 3.

We will need parent drivers for Saturday, January 28 for Districts and Saturday, February 11 to for Regionals. Locations for both of these events are still to be determined. With parent drivers, if some students need to leave early for solo-ensembles, dances, etc., we can TRY TO make arrangements - NO PROMISES! Parents, if you can drive, please e-mail me at jhazle@egrps.org or call my voice mail at 235-7599 ext. 5256 and I'll get you details. We will need 8 drivers; that's the minimum based upon 6 passenger vans. I DO NOT allow students to drive. It's winter, we're traveling long distances, and we get tired. If we qualify for State, we will also need drivers in the early am Friday, February 17. We stay overnight for States and need drivers to also stay the night with us as chaperones and drivers. We would return on the evening of Saturday, February 18.
